Printout and cut around cards

Materials: Lotto card for each player, sufficient coins to cover cards; money dice with appropriate amounts. These can be made up by covering 6 sides with relevant coins stickers.

Tip: for all levels, after a few games, try having more coins of some and less of others and encourage pupils to make up the amount needed with smaller coins such as: if 10p is needed and there are no 10p coins left, pupil makes this up with 2 x 5ps or 5 x 2ps placing appropriately on their cards..

How to Play:

Easy level: Use one die, match amounts, You can make this more fun by giving out stickers or 'points' (which need totalling at the end of the game).

1 point for completing a horizontal row

1 point for a vertical row

3 points for the player who has filled all rows, finishing first.

Teacher goes first – to show how to play. When adding up totals, show how to count up by using the largest coin first, and so on.

Player tosses the die says the amount, finds the coin and covers the correct amount on the card. When a player completes a row, he/she totals up the coins and writes the amount in pencil in the empty square. Don't forget when a row is completed vertically, this can also be totalled up. (If you would like the connecting writing practise then add a blank row underneath (after unlocking padlock on the icon bar!).

Medium level: Use two dice, pupils can match two amounts, or add them together if it matches an amount needed on their card.

Play as above.

Harder level: Quick way to complete card: Use two dice add together, for example $50p + 20p = 70p$ then covers more than one amount on the card with coins such as, 50p, 10p, 5p and 5p, or 50p, 10p and 10p if available. This speeds up the game and provides lots of mental calculations!
